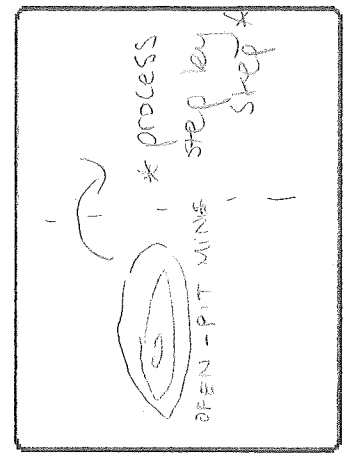
Intro: Jeopardy game show. Jerry is posed w/ the answer: THIS is what light bulbs are made of.



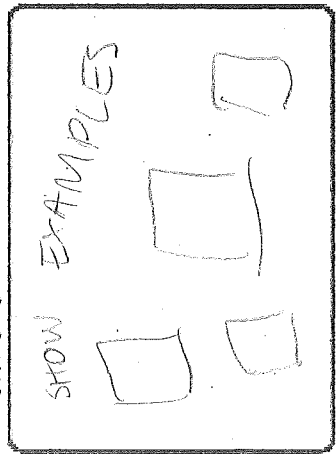
(Transition to whiteboard) EXPLAINS FILAMENTS are made from a metal called tungsten (appearance, properties)



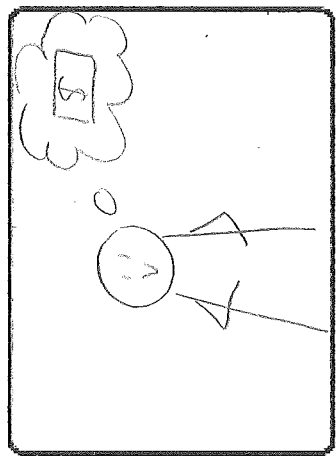

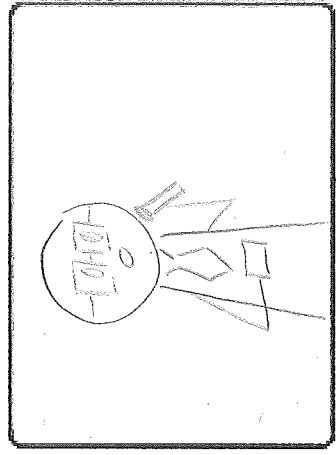
HOW IT IS PROCESSED: dissolve, purify, evaporate, crystallize, pull into wires + extracted



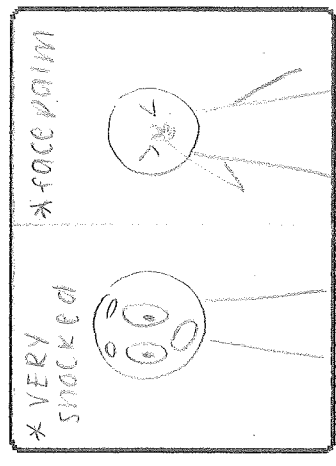
